- Bow North and South TIF financial statements:
- Any development in both districts would depend on the capacity available, for sewer especially.
- Examples of development sites where water and sewer capacity were crucial for proposed improvements;
- The need to use some of the TIF funds to come up with a Master Plan for the area (South Bow and Hooksett) which would be very helpful for any prospective development in the area.
- Need for the BOS to begin discussing sewer capacity with Hooksett in order to gage their commitment for the South Bow area.

Mr. Charbonneau made a motion to recommend to the Bow Selectboard meeting with the Town of Hooksett to discuss the possibility of spending some of the TIF funds in order to draft a Master Plan for the South Bow area, which could be used to come up with solutions for that area. Mr. Bates duly seconded and motion passed unanimously.
