

**Board of Selectmen
Approved Minutes
Thursday, February 17, 2022**

On Thursday, February 17, 2022 at 5:30 p.m., the Board of Selectmen met in Meeting Room A, at the Town of Bow Municipal Building, 10 Grandview Road, Bow, NH.

I. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Chris Nicolopoulos called the meeting to order. Present: Chairman Chris Nicolopoulos, Vice Chairman Bruce Marshall, Selectman Colleen Hunter, Selectman Michael Wayne, Town Manager David Stack, Administrative Assistant Tonia Lindquist, and members of the public.

II. PUBLIC COMMENT

Bryan Westover, 63 Robinson Road, Mr. Westover asked the Board to reconsider their vote that allowed a banner supporting the community group for a cell tower to be placed on the hill by the gazebo. This is a banner asking residents to vote yes on March 9, 2022 for a cell tower.

The general consensus of the Board was the banner message would be for the betterment of the Town and for the safety of schools and residents.

III. PUBLIC HEARING

Chairman Nicolopoulos opened the public hearing for comment at 5:43 p.m. to discuss Warrant Article 14, to establish a Regional Transportation Improvement Capital Reserve Fund. Hearing no public comments Chairman Nicolopoulos closed the public hearing at 5:45 p.m.

IV. DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS

1. Turee Pond access Road

Vice Chair Marshall discussed with the Board, Director Sweeney's request to plow the access road to Turee Pond for this weekend's Fish and Game demonstration. The Board unanimously were in agreement to have the access road plowed before the upcoming demonstration.

2. Mask Policy at Bow Recreation Center

The Board reviewed an email dated February 15, 2022 from Parks and Recreation Director Darcy Little concerning the current mask policy for students. The School Board will be meeting in the near future to discuss removing the mask mandate and Director Little is recommending that Bow Recreation Center follow suit, to stay consistent with the schools mask policy.

A MOTION was made by Selectman Hunter and duly seconded by Selectman Wayne to support Director Little's recommendation to follow the school guidelines concerning removal of the mask policy, if the school decides to remove the mask policy. MOTION PASSED 5-0.

V. NON-PUBLIC SESSION - NH RSA 91-A:3, II (a) Personnel discipline, promotion or compensation.

At 6:15 p.m. A MOTION was made by Selectman Poulin and duly seconded by Selectman Hunter to go into a non-public session, and a roll call was taken. Chairman Nicolopoulos – yes, Vice Chair Marshall – yes, Selectman Hunter – yes, Selectman Poulin – yes, Selectman Wayne – yes. MOTION PASSED 5-0.
