



# Bow Annual Water Testing

With COVID-19 restricting travel and keeping us inside, we're all working, playing, and educating our children at home. Make sure your well water is free of common impurities such as bacteria, lead, radon, and arsenic so that your family is safe indoors as well as outdoors!

The Bow Drinking Water Protection Committee will hold its annual water testing event for Bow residents at the Bow Community Center, Saturday June 5 and Sunday June 6, 2021. Drive-through and pick up your water sample kit contact-free on Saturday, collect your samples first thing Sunday morning, and drop it off along with payment for the Committee to deliver it to the State Lab. Your test results are confidential and will be mailed directly to you within 3 to 4 weeks.

Payment due with sample drop-off, Check Payable to “**Treasurer, State of NH**”

Recommended testing: Standard Analysis \$85 (Includes Arsenic, Uranium, Bacteria, Lead, Copper, Nitrate, Nitrite, Iron, Manganese, pH, Sodium, Chloride, Fluoride, Hardness). Add Radon (Recommended) for an additional \$20 and a total cost of \$105.
