Situation Overview

The Town buildings are open to the public and in accordance with social distancing the State's re-opening "Best practices Guidance". The New Hampshire Declared State of Emergency is no longer in effect. The EOC has reduced operational hours to daily between the hours of 0800 and 1200 hours (M-F), at the **Steady Level** to maintain situational awareness and coordinate Town response related activities. This will be the last **Sit-Rep unless the situation dictates otherwise.**

Incident Priorities

- Ensure workforce health and safety as it relates to employee exposure and infection control.
- Identifying and fulfilling community needs as it relates to food insecurities and Human Services.
- Continuity of EOC/Town Operations.
- Prevention as it relates to social distancing, sanitation, exposure monitoring, and quarantining of goods and services.

Objectives for Next Operational Period

- Ensure the safety of citizens, staff, and response personnel throughout the incident and continue to evaluate community needs.
- Continue to evaluate essential government functions based on latest information.
- Continue coordination efforts between State, Local, and private partners.
- Participate in HSEM conference calls.
- Monitor the Governors press conferences.
- Continue working on the Library Generator grant.
- Distribute weekly Sit-Rep and EMD Summary Updates.

EOC Activities Completed During the Previous Operational Period

- Updated the Incident Action Plan (IAP), Incident Logs, Status Board, and related documents.
- Monitored HHS Emergency Services database to track hospital surge.
- Continued to monitored potential employee exposures and business exposures.
- Monitored the weather and issued advisories as necessary.
- Participate in HSEM EMD and Legal Conference calls.
- Monitored the Governor's press conferences.
- Continued to monitor conditions at the adult living communities.
- Updated the Town website with vaccination info.
- Monitored the SAU School operating status.
- Distributed Vaccine clinics update.
- Continued to monitor Town daycare operations.
- Continue to handle citizen's inquiries regarding Town reopening.
- Continue to provide COVID-19 information to our constituents. (EMD Summary/Sit-REP 1 weekly)
- Continued to work on a generator grant proposal for the Library.
- Monitored Fire, EMS, and Police Department's calls for assistance.

Status of the Concord Bridge replacement.

Birchdale Road Bridge over Bela Brook This work began Monday 5/24/2021. In order to replace the bridge, Birchdale Road will be **CLOSED** to all traffic 24/7 until approximately Friday 11/15/2021; no vehicles will be able to pass between #90 to Clinton Street.

New Hampshire drought conditions have not improved as groundwater levels remain low and the severity level is at **Abnormally Dry**.

Vaccination appointments registration is now open to anyone 12 years of age and older.

Weather

Saturday: Showers likely, mainly before 11am. Cloudy, then gradually becoming mostly sunny, with a high near 75. Calm wind becoming southwest around 5 mph. Chance of precipitation is 60%. New precipitation amounts of less than a tenth of an inch possible.

Saturday Night: Partly cloudy, with a low around 54. South wind around 5 mph becoming calm in the evening.

Sunday: A 30 percent chance of showers after 1pm. Mostly sunny, with a high near 82. Calm wind becoming southwest around 5 mph in the afternoon.

Sunday Night: A 50 percent chance of showers. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 56.

Monday: A chance of showers, with thunderstorms also possible after 2pm. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 74. Chance of precipitation is 50%.

Monday Night: A chance of showers and thunderstorms before 8pm, then a chance of showers between 8pm and 2am. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 55. Chance of precipitation is 30%.

Tuesday: A 40 percent chance of showers after 8am. Partly sunny, with a high near 78.

Tuesday Night: A 30 percent chance of showers before 2am. Partly cloudy, with a low around 53.

Wednesday: A 30 percent chance of showers. Mostly sunny, with a high near 73.

Wednesday Night: Partly cloudy, with a low around 51.

Thursday: Mostly sunny, with a high near 76.

Thursday Night: Partly cloudy, with a low around 54.

Friday: Mostly sunny, with a high near 82.
