COVID-19 VIRUS
VOTING DAY PROCEDURES
(BASED ON CURRENT CDC GUIDANCE AND STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE
UNIVERSAL BEST PRACTICES)
TOWN AND SCHOOL MEETINGS: MARCH 8, 2022

1. All persons will be encouraged, but not required, to wear a mask in the polling place for the health and safety of all. Masks will be provided to those who wish to wear one.
2. Election workers and election officials will be protected by table screens or other barriers, if they so wish.
3. To separate lines, registered voters will enter the Community Center by way of the new doorway that has been installed in one of the old Fire Department garage doors, and unregistered voters will enter the Community Center by way of the main entrance facing Bow Center Road.
4. Voting booths and other high-touch areas will be sanitized throughout the day.
5. Voters will be provided with single-use pens that they may recycle as they exit the polling place.
6. Voters who are uncomfortable voting in person may either vote as an Outside Absentee Voter, or may request and cast an absentee ballot prior to voting day.
7. If you are an election worker or election official and cannot make each of the following statements, please do not enter the polling place. If you wish to vote, but cannot make each of the following statements and wish to vote, please cast an absentee ballot, use the Outside Absentee Voter option or let the Moderator know before entering the polling place:
 - I have not tested positive for COVID-19 during the past 5 days.
 - If I tested positive for COVID-19 between 5-10 days ago, I have no symptoms or my symptoms are resolving and I will wear a mask at all times in the polling place.
 - If I was exposed to someone with COVID-19 during the past 10 days, but I have (a) completed the primary series of a CDC-approved COVID-19 vaccine and received a booster shot, and (b) I have not developed any COVID-19 symptoms, then I will wear a mask at all times in the polling place.
 - If I am either (a) not vaccinated, or (b) I have not completed the primary series of a CDC-approved COVID-19 vaccine and received a booster shot within the recommended time period, I have not been exposed to someone with COVID-19 during the past 5 days.
 - If I have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 between 5-10 days ago, and I am either (a) not vaccinated, or (b) I have not completed the primary series of a

CDC-approved COVID-19 vaccine and received a booster shot within the recommended time period and (c) I have not developed COVID-19 symptoms, then I will wear a mask at all times in the polling place.
