- Registration will stay open until program is full.
- If program is full, call (603)223-3920 to be added to a wait list.
- Payments accepted: Online registrations must be paid for with credit card. (A 2.79% convenience fee and a \$0.25 cent transaction fee is added to credit card purchases.) Checks made out to "Town of Bow" are accepted for mail-in registrations and walk-ins.
- You may request that your child be put in the same group as one other camper at time of registration. We will do our best to honor requests.
