- Payments accepted: Online registrations must be paid with a credit card. (A 2.99% convenience fee is added to credit card purchases. Minimum \$2.50 charge.) Checks made out to "Town of Bow" are accepted for mail-in, walk-in and drop-box registrations.
- Summer Camp fees, Registration fees, Early Care fees, Field Trip Fees and CIT fees are non-refundable and non-transferrable.
- You may request that your child be put in the same group as one other camper (same grade) at time of registration. We will do our best to honor requests.
